

Dr. James Bjork of the Hunter Holmes McGuire VA Medical Center in Richmond Virginia (RICVAMC) and Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) is recruiting a cognitive or behavioral neuroscientist postdoc for The Interprofessional Polytrauma and Traumatic Brain Injury Rehabilitation Research (P/TBI) Fellowship at RICVAMC. This is a two-year postdoctoral fellowship for human-subject research training in an interdisciplinary research program devoted to understanding mechanisms of comorbidity between traumatic brain injury (TBI) and suicidality, substance use disorder, and other mental health disorders. The primary goal of this track of the P/TBI Fellowship program is to develop non-clinician investigators who will have the research skill set, grantsmanship, administrative (VA) perspective, and clinical perspective to advance TBI-related rehabilitation.
